Latoya was a visitor of Alberta's and after her second visit she asked to know more about salvation. Latoya is in her midtwenties, comes from a traditional back ground, has three little girls and this was her first time to ever be in a church. God is good, so good!

2019 Vision

We have tried over the past seven year to always put together a "Vision Statement" for the year; it helps us to make some goals and also for ya'll to know how to pray for us and what we pray to accomplish during the year. This year our Vision Statement will be small, and prayerfully have a huge impact.

Our prayer and vision for 2019 is to see the church body grow spiritually. We will continue to teach on basic bible doctrine and creation to give them a biblical foundation for future growth. We are excited to see Alberta sharing her faith openly with family and friends and we pray that all of our congregation will grow to share their faith also.

Our huge project on the radar for 2019 is the acquisition of property by the highway to relocate our church. Which would mean building a new church facility in the future. This is a slow process, as nothing Navajo Government takes place quickly. We are not able to buy land, but instead we have to apply for a lifetime lease. We are also requesting a 10 acre site; the government has placed a one acre restriction on church sites. The local chapter has approved the request but we still need approval by the Indian Affairs. We know that in the Lord's timing everything will fall into place. We are beyond excited what this could mean for the future of the church and the numerous opportunities that this could open for ministry and outreach.
