We are looking forward to continuing to minister at Mexican Water Baptist Church this upcoming year, and are praying for continued growth among our church family. We also have a burden to continue reaching the community of Mexican Water. This year we have several church activities planned to minister to our church family. Our first church fellowship will be in the month of February as we are able to once again have our Friendship Banquet after having to cancel due to Covid Re- strictions for the past several years.

During the month of March we have a groups from the C.L.A.I.M.S Ministry, and Bro. Tackett, to help us remodel our church fellowship area.
