A Note from Pastor Damon

Dear Victory Family of Faith,

Wow, Eastern Carolina weather is hard to predict. When I was in elementary school, I was taught the season of Spring comes in like a lion and goes out like a lamb? I think this year we are experiencing the entrance of Spring backwards. When it is 84 degrees in February it is hard to say it is roaring in like a lion. I think we all would agree with that statement. However, as a life-long resident of coastal Carolina I can say things can change quickly. I have witnessed some of the worst snowstorms in the month of March and short sleeve shirts on Christmas day. The seasons of life can surprise us at times when it comes to the work of God. We do not always know the purpose of it or even know He is working in our lives until He has finished, and we then can see His hands holding us by His side as He carries us through the fierceness of the storm. The storms are not easy, they can be very trying at times, but they are needed at times for God to mold us into the image of His Son. We can be assured that He is working for good in us and for us. Romans 8:28 says, "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." What a promise we have from God, even when we don't see Him coming or going. However, the evidence that He was there cannot be missed because of the difference He made in the heart and life of His child He tenderly walked with.

In John Chapter 3, Jesus used the coming and going of the wind as an example of the work of the Holy Spirit, working in the life of an unbeliever drawing sinners to the Father through Christ, who is the Way. Jesus said the new birth is like the blowing of the wind. Just as the wind is unseen, we don't know where it comes from nor where it is going. He is able to transform us into new creations in Christ. Jesus affirmed that everyone needs to be born again by the Holy Spirit from above. When the Spirit of God blows into a person's life, they are moved and changed for the glory of God. When we are changed from above, there is evidence of that change in every part of our life. The evidence of change is clearly seen in the life of Nicodemus. He first came to lesus under the cover of night seeking to know who He was. Growing in his faith he defended Jesus before the high priest. In faith he asked for Jesus' body at His death. The Holy Spirit makes an overwhelming change in the life of a born-again believer.




